The Generations Cup

Deed of gift

Introduction

The Generations Cup is donated by 8mR Frøya and presented by Yacht Club Langenargen and the Lake Of Constance Eight Metre Association. The Generations Cup shall be held by IEMA and raced for in accordance with following rules and detailed class instructions from IEMA. If possible at the same time as the World Cup.

- 1.0 In order to qualify for the Generations Cup an International 8-Metre yacht shall have a valid certificate of rating and comply with the measurement Rules of the different age groups and their respective Rating Certificates. The existing Rating Certificates qualifying for the Generations Cup are First Rule, Neptune, Sira and Modern.
- 2.0 Boat design and construction Each boat shall comply with the applicable rules of their group.
- 3.0 Scoring

The competition for the Generations Cup shall be scored from each race of the event without discards (if any). The positions of each yacht shall be used for a separate high point scoring system in the respective classes. The high point system incorporates the number of participants starting in each class giving the first place the number of starters plus one i.e. By 5 starters the first place gets 6 points second 5 etc. with a maximum of 7 points for the first place.

By 5 starters the first place gets 6 points second 5 etc. with a maximum of 7 points for the first place. The highest overall scoring will be the winner of the Generations Cup. See appendix. A

- 4.0 The Races shall be governed by the sailing instructions of the regatta.
- 5.0 The Trophy shall be held by the current Champion's Yacht Club which shall be responsible for engraving and for ensuring the safe keeping of the Trophy while it is in their custody.
- 6.0 Only the Lake Of Constance Eight Metre Association shall make alterations to these Rules
- 7.0 The IEMA Technical Committee governs the 8-Metre Generations Cup Rules. Amendments, if any, shall be submitted to the Lake Of Constance Eight Metre Association who will also act as arbiter in case of dispute over the said rules.

Appendix A

Determination of the winner of the Generation Cup

Eligible: the participants of the classes First Rule, Neptune, Sira and, Modern

No discards

Maximum score for the first place: 7 points

Maximum participants from the rating list: 6

If there are less than 6 participants in a rating class, the value for x (maximum score) is the number of registered participants in this rating class + 1

Scoring for each race:

Score	Points
1	7
2	6
3	5
4	4
5	3
6	2

In case of equality in the overall result, the highest ranking goes to the boat, which

- 1. Has sailed the largest number of races.
- 2. Has the largest number of participants in its class
- 3. Scored the best result in the last race. (etc. see also WR A8.2)
- 4. Achieved a better overall ranking (overall ranking across all classes)
